

## "Yamazaki Mazak Corporation Minokamo Plant"

A tour to Yamazaki Mazak Corporation Minokamo Plant will be held as a Leadership Development Seminar (LDS) ["monozukuri" tour]. The company is one of the global leading makers of mother machines. The tour offers you an opportunity to visit and observe their factory and to take a special technical lecture for the structure of mother machines, history of innovation and so on. Your participation is highly welcome.

- **Place:** Yamazaki Mazak Corporation Minokamo Plant (Naka-Hachiya-cho, Minokamo City, Gifu-Pref.)



- **Date:** Friday, May 9<sup>th</sup>

Meet at the rotary near the east exit of Inuyama Station (Nagoya railway) at 13:30 and move by the charter bus. End at 17:30 at Inuyama Station. Free to participate to the tour. Transportation expenses will be paid by LGS later.

- **Schedule (expected)**

13 : 30	Meet at the rotary near east exit of Inuyama Station (Nagoya Railway "Meitetsu").
13 : 30~14 : 00	Move to Yamazaki Mazak Corporation Minokamo Plant by charter bus.
14 : 00~14 : 45	Lecture (introduction of the corporation, structure of mother machine, and so on).
14 : 45~16 : 45	Factory tour (English explanation will be available.)
16 : 45~17 : 00	Question and answer session
17 : 00~17 : 30	Move to Inuyama Station by charter bus
17 : 30	Break up at Inuyama Station

- **Remarks for participation**

The requirements and conditions to participate the LDS series will be also applied to the tour, such as tardiness prohibition, report submission and so on. Attendance to the tour is equivalent to that to a LDS regardless of the tour duration. Unlike the other LDS series, application is necessary because of the preparation. The tour explanation can be provided in either English or Japanese and the language preference should be specified in the application.

- **Remarks for international students**

Some international students may not be applicable due to the restriction given by the Foreign Exchange and Foreign Trade Act. For this restriction, you are required to describe the nationality and the residence (months) in Japan. Your understanding and cooperation are highly appreciated.
