• **Notice**

- The tour is regarded as one of the Leadership Development Seminar series, independent of the tour duration. You will be required to submit a report for the Grade Point (GP) evaluation. If you are late for the tour, you will be regarded as absent strictly. (You can still join the tour, though.)
